RE: Number Plate Covers

I refer to your letter of 17 February 1993 in which you have sought approval under the provisions of Regulation 4.12(4) of the Transport Infrastructure (Roads) Regulations for your number plate covers.

Following an evaluation of your sample number plate frames, I am pleased to advise that approval is granted for the covers under the brand name of "Easy Fix" and "King Pin".

However, you might consider it appropriate to include on your packaging a statement indicating that the number plate covers should only be attached to plates which are not in any way bent or distorted, allowing the ingress of moisture or dust to obscure the number plate. The covers should be replaced if they become damaged, discoloured or in any way affect the legibility of the number plate.

A copy of this approval has been forwarded to the Chief Superintendent of Police, State Traffic Support Group, Queensland Police Service, for his information.

Sample covers forwarded to this office for evaluation are enclosed.
